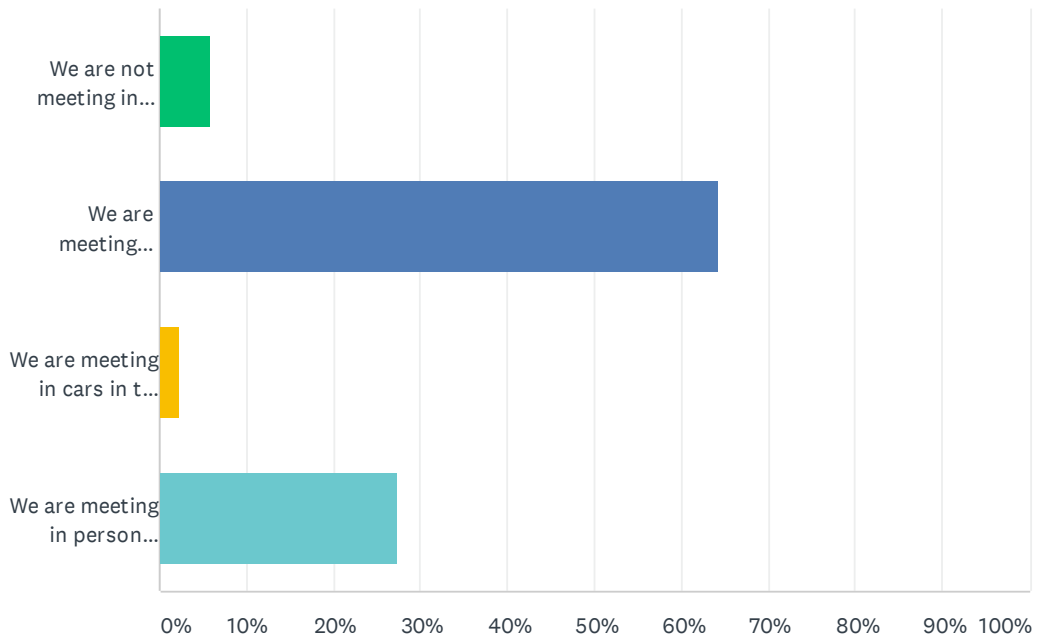


Q1 How would you describe how your church is currently meeting for Sunday Worship

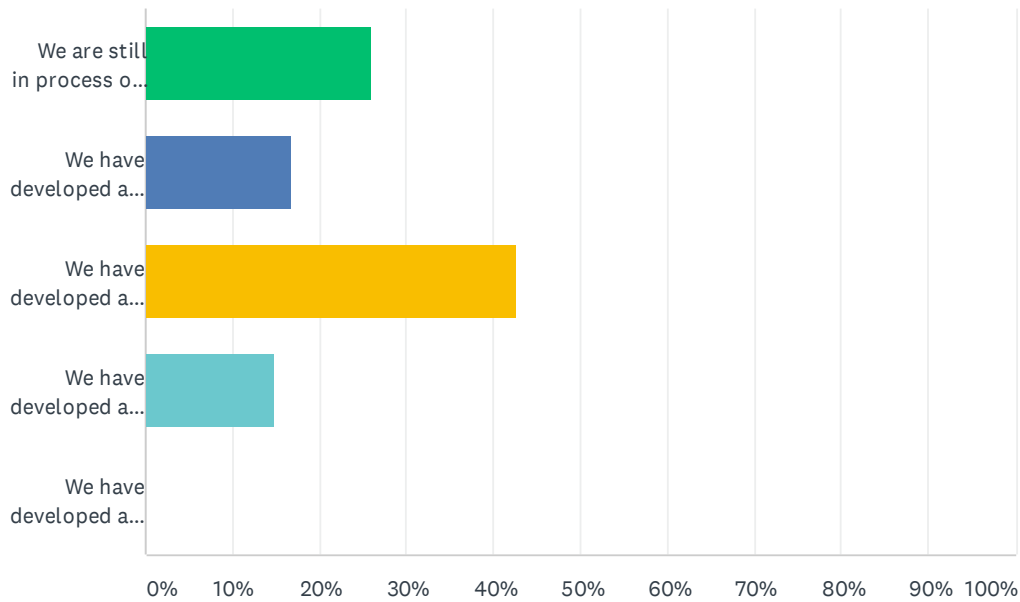

Q2 Which statement best describes your plans for transitioning to meeting in person for worship.

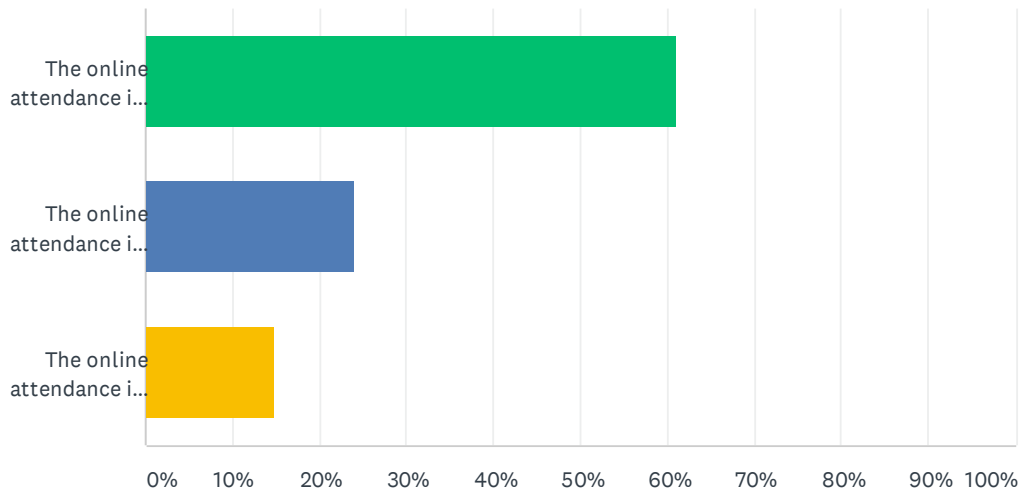

Q3 How has the number of people participating in an online service compared to your regular attendance in person before the Pandemic?

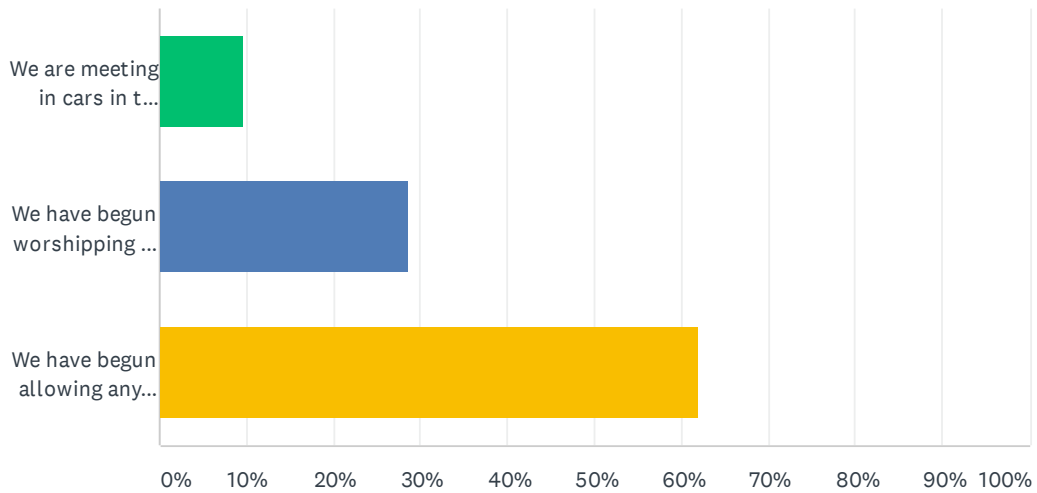

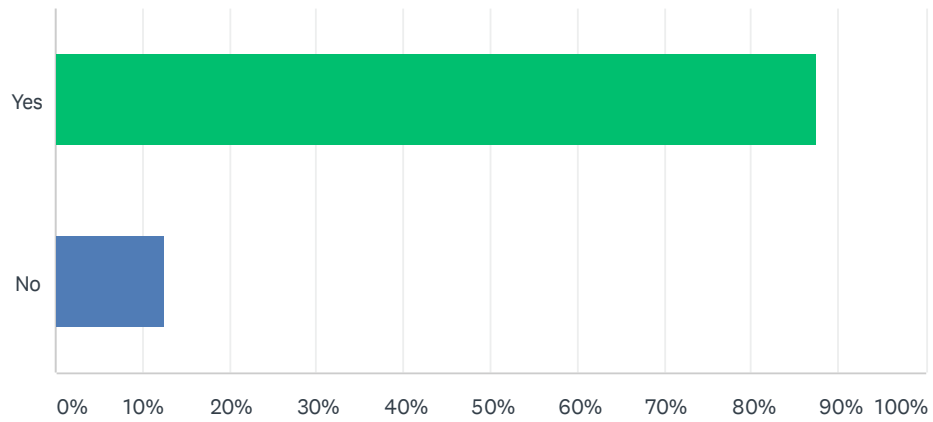

Q6 When you offer in person worship, do you plan to continuing to offer a live streaming option?

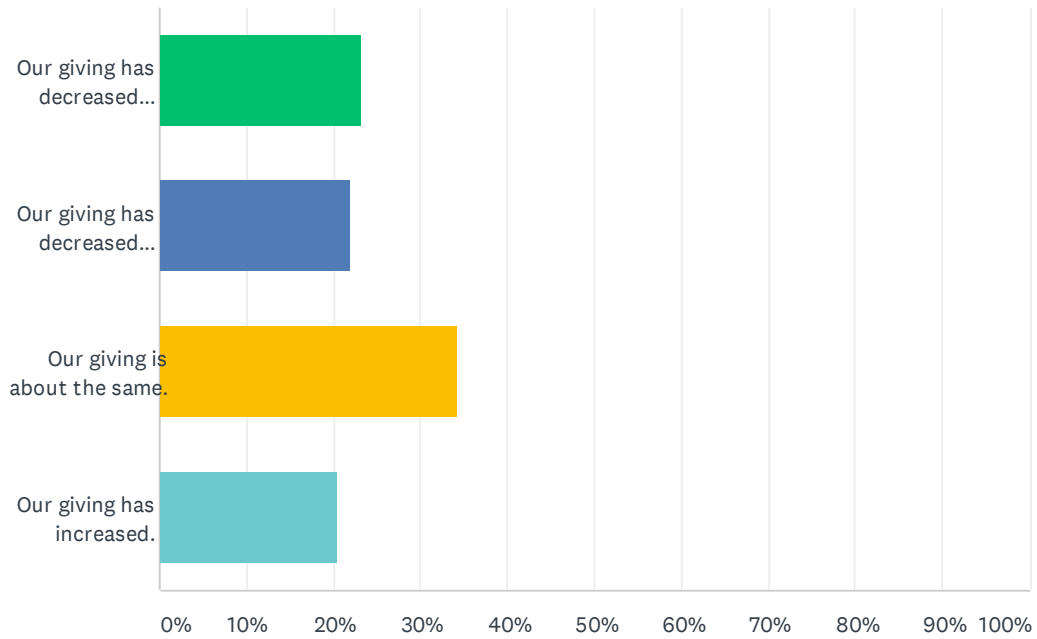

Q7 How has the giving in your church been impacted by the Pandemic?

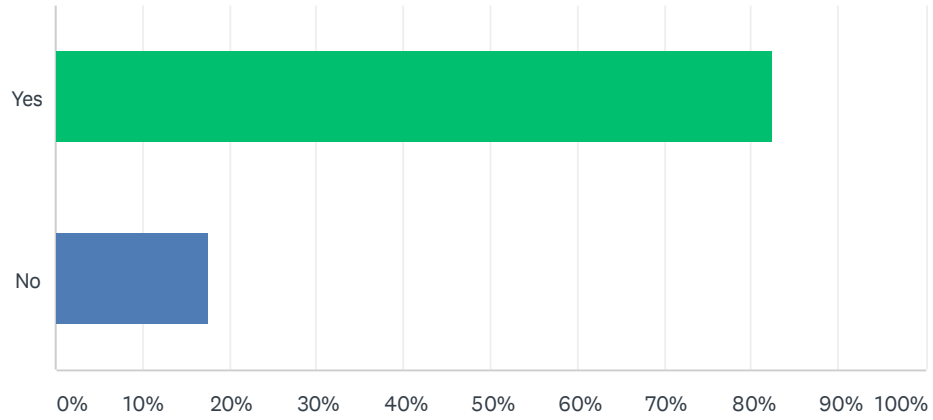

Q8 Do you give an online option to give?

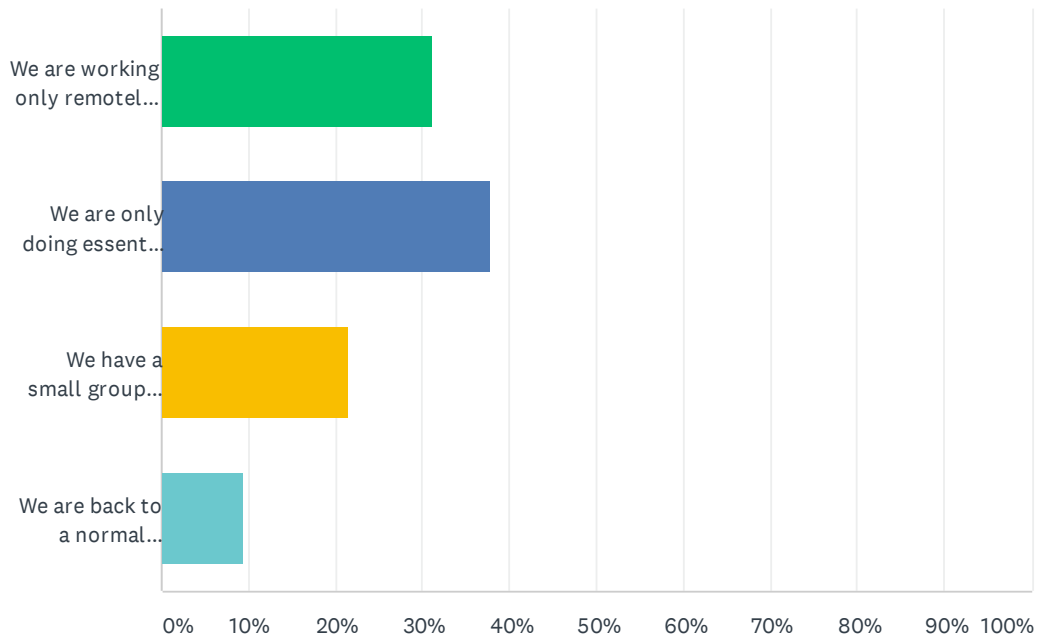
